What is the "GREEN TEAM DEDICATION TREE?"

This year, to raise environmental awareness, the Bryant Ranch and Travis Ranch GREEN TEAM will hang ornaments with students' Earth Week pledges on a tree at Travis Ranch during the week of April 26-30th.

What is an Earth Week Pledge?

It is a commitment to be kind to the Earth from April 19-23. Examples are below...

DIY INSTRUCTIONS

You will need the following items:

- 2"x2" flat piece of rigid plastic Ideas: cut up plastic milk gallons, strawberry containers, or water bottles.
- permanent marker (Sharpies work great!)

OPTIONAL

- hole puncher
- piece of string

Instructions:

Commit to an Earth Week pledge from April 19-23. You can choose one of the following, or make up your own:

- I will use only reusable utensils, food containers, water bottles, etc.
- I will pick up trash around my community.
- I will ride my bike or walk to school.
- I will upcycle a single-use plastic item by turning something used into something new.
- I will eat vegetarian meals.
- 1. Use a permanent marker to write your Earth Week pledge on the plastic.
- 2. You can decorate the ornament with colors or paint, but remember, it will hang outside for 1 week.
- 3. If you have a hole puncher, punch a hole in your plastic ornament, if not, the GREEN TEAM will do it for you. Then, weave your string through the hole and tie a knot.
- 4. Turn your ornament into school before April 23rd. You can turn it into your teacher, or collection boxes will be in the front offices.
